Pedagogical Sequences

The GreenGUARDens team has provided 16 Pedagogical Sequences to give you an idea of how to organize a lesson. Three very important, but also complex topics are covered in an interesting and understandable way for children.

Structure of plans

The plan suggests the materials you need for the activity, as well as useful links to help you prepare as well as possible.

There are also advices on how to adapt the activity to all children, as well as various sustainability tips.

Interactive games

Each interactive activity is described step by step. Some of the activities are role play, memory game, treasure hunt, guessing game, but also a visit to the forest or park. It is recommended that children make all the necessary costumes and play equipment themselves (with the help of teachers) and use recycled materials such as old paper, cardboard, plastic that they can bring from home.
